They often serve as performance consultants in human resource and training departments with a human performance improvement focus. Graduates of this program are trained to: Lead and manage HPT initiatives and processes in a variety of environments, working effectively with others to accomplish organizational goals; Analyze complex, real-world individual and organizational goals; Design, develop, implement and evaluate interventions in a wide variety of settings; and Organize, manage, and evaluate business environments.
